HTML BASICS

DOCUMENT TITLE

Please include a title in the head of the document

- Title for the page that is less than 80 characters and describes your site.

NAVIGATION

Use a list for inter-page navigation

- Within a nav tag, use a ul and at least two linked anchor tags to link to your pages together

HEADING TAGS

Please include the following HTML markup within the body.

- Within the header tag use an h1 for the topic name h2 for a tagline
- At least three (h2) headings for sub-headlines within the pages
- At least four paragraph (p) tags.

OTHER TAGS

Please include the following HTML markup within the body.

- One block quote used appropriately.
- Two or more html comments.
- One or more break tags. (creates a single space)

LIST ELEMENTS

Please include the following HTML markup within the body.

- Include an unordered list with a minimum of 5 items. (the ul in the nav does NOT count)
- Include an ordered list (minimum of 5 items)
- Include a definition list with a minimum of three terms and three definitions

INLINE ELEMENTS

Please include the following HTML markup in the paragraphs of your site.

- Use the appropriate inline elements to add italic text. (DO NOT use with a heading)
- Use the appropriate inline elements to add bold text. (DO NOT use with a heading)

HTML ENTITIES

Please include a footer at the bottom of BOTH pages. In the footer, include these entities that are not easily entered from the keyboard.

- Include a copyright symbol
- Include one or more bullets
- Within the footer tag show the date and your name

LINKS TO OTHER SITES WITH TARGETS

Create two links from your about.html page to a related site. For example, if you like cooking, link to some cooking sites.

- Link to another site that opens a new page
- Link to another site that opens a new page
